

## 105 MM ILLUM M314A3

This round is used for 105 mm howitzer M52 and M52A1 (M49 gun), M101 and M101A1 (M2A1 and M2A2 guns), M108 (M103 gun) and M56 Pack Howitzer.

Used for signaling or for illuminating a designated area smoke screens and signals with a limited incendiary effect.

Once the fuze setting time has elapsed, the fuze operates and ingites the expulsion charge. The combustion gases separate the flare And the parachute and also produce ignition of the lare. At this time the opening of the flare fins takes place and its rotation is braked.
